Andrews Opens Her Office to Promote Arts, Sciences & Regional Tourism



Second Franklin State Representative Denise Andrews (D-Orange) announced today that she, like some of her colleagues at the State House has opened up her Boston office to showcase some of the great works of residents from her district. “I represent a diverse district, stretching from Greenfield in the West to Athol in the East. We possess a truly astounding amount of talent in the arts, trades and sciences. The inspiration for this project comes mainly from Senator Stan Rosenberg, himself a supporter of the arts and culture.” Senator Rosenberg regularly shows the works of local artists in his State House office.

Andrews will highlight original works of visual artists, engineers, scientists and innovators on a rotating basis. “I have a small office, but with plenty of open wall space. This is a simple way to remind the outside world that there is life and talent beyond the Boston Metro area. Members of the House of Representatives will be invited to view the works on display. I regularly host

meetings with constituents, business leaders and community organizations. Very few get away without an area guide and sales pitch to visit our district,” noted Andrews.

“I just finished hanging the first work to be shown. It is a spectacular untitled acrylic painting by Marla Cromwell of Orange,” shared Andrews. Marla holds a Master’s Degree in Art Education and taught art at the Wooster School in Connecticut for sixteen years before moving to Massachusetts. While in Connecticut, she participated in several group and solo showings of her work. Marla continues to produce her own work and teaches classes in painting, drawing and visual journaling.
